Air Niugini to Commence Service to FSM

Air Niugini will commence twice weekly flights between Port Moresby, Papa New Guinea on December 3, 2016.

Three special flights were operated

in September of this year to Chuuk and Pohnpei. The flight time from Port Moresby to Chuuk is 2 hours and 40 minutes.

Air Niugini will be operating two flights a week, every Wednesdays and Saturdays and will be able to carry domestic passengers between Pohnpei and Chuuk.

The establishment of Air Niugini's service is a result of an Air Services Agreement between the Governments of Papua New Guinea and the Federated States of Micronesia.

PATA CEO, Mario Hardy reported


in the recent New Tourism Frontier Forum 2016 which took place from November 23-26, 2016 in Bangladesh.


